

Getting started with Libby

Libby lets you download free e-books, e-audiobooks, and e-magazines to your device using your library card.

On a phone or tablet

1. From the App Store, download the app **Libby** and open
2. Search for your library using your zip code
 - First you'll select **Southwest Virginia Public Libraries**
 - Then select **Jefferson-Madison Regional Library**
3. Enter your library card number to log in
4. **Browse** for material by tapping the icon at the bottom that looks like a library building, or **search** for specific titles using the magnifying glass.
5. **Check out** or **place a hold** on titles that interest you.
6. Happy reading!



With a Kindle

You cannot access Libby directly from your Kindle. Instead, you'll need to check out items using a phone, tablet, or computer, and then send to Kindle.

1. Go to **Account**, then **Settings**, then "**Read Books With...**" and select **Kindle**. Now your loans will default to Kindle (when available).
2. When you check out a title, select "**Read with Kindle.**" This will open a new window that will direct you to Amazon, where you will need to sign in to your Amazon account.
3. Once logged into Amazon, click "**Get Library Book.**" You will be redirected to Libby.
4. Connect your Kindle to wifi and turn on sync. Your loan will download shortly!

On a computer

1. From your internet browser, go to **libbyapp.com**
2. Search for your library using your zip code
 - First you'll select **Southwest Virginia Public Libraries**
 - Then select **Jefferson-Madison Regional Library**
3. Enter your library card number to log in
4. **Browse** for materials by clicking the icon at the bottom that looks like a library building, or **search** for specific titles using the magnifying glass.
5. **Check out** or **place a hold** on titles that interest you.
6. Happy reading!



Search

Use Search to find specific titles, authors, or genres. You can also use the filters to limit by format, availability, age, and more.



Browse

Imagine walking into a digital version of your local library, with books on display curated by librarians. Discover your next great read here!



Account

You won't need this menu often, but this is your account where you can add or remove your library card(s), change your settings, and more.



Shelf

Your shelf shows you the items you have checked out now, the books you have on hold, and any books you have "tagged" (a way of making lists). Go to your shelf to open your current read.



Timeline

Go to your timeline to see a history of all the books you have checked out or put on hold, even once you've finished and returned them.
