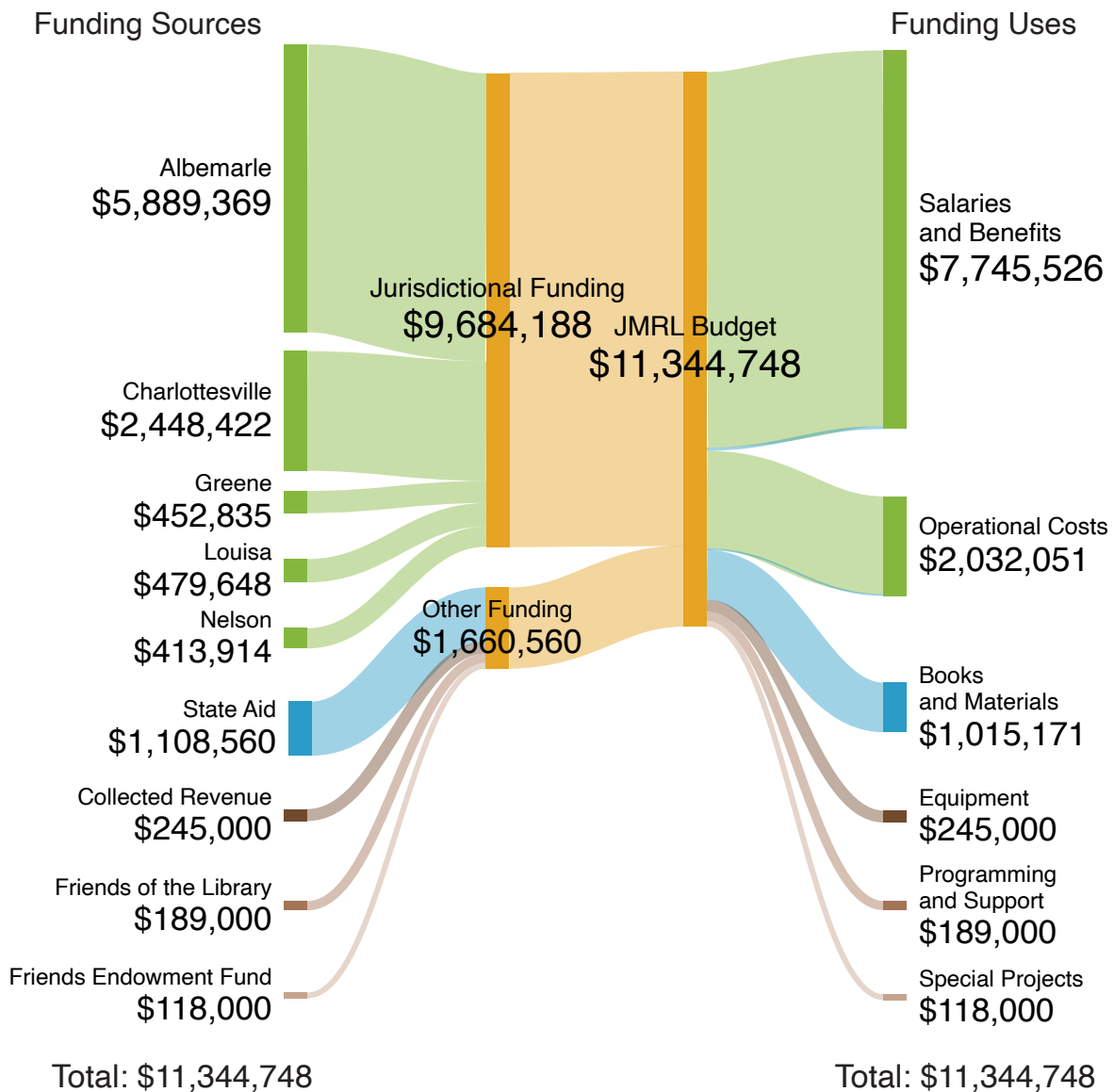


JMRL FY26 Budget Info



JMRL is one of the largest regional library systems in Virginia, made up of eight branches and a bookmobile serving five jurisdictions. The majority of operational funding (primarily used for staffing and daily services) is provided by the localities of Albemarle, Charlottesville, Greene, Louisa, and Nelson. Other funding sources include State Aid for books and materials, Friends of the Library support for programming and special projects, and revenue generated by JMRL for technology and equipment. Collectively these funds enable JMRL to provide the high-level library service that patrons expect and deserve.
